The William Carey Scholarship | 2020 Secondary Years

The William Carey Scholarship was created to offer educational opportunities for students who are either first-generation descendants of a refugee or are refugees themselves. It is a means-tested scholarship for eligible families on a limited income.

This scholarship is named after the pioneering Baptist missionary William Carey, who famously urged, 'Expect great things from God. Attempt great things for God'. Carey is remembered as a father of modern missions, a gifted linguist and educator and was responsible for translating the Bible into 44 different languages and dialects.

Eligibility Guidelines

In order to meet the eligibility criteria for this scholarship, students must:

- be a Secondary student or commencing Secondary in 2020
- be an Australian citizen, or on an Australian permanent humanitarian or residential visa;
- be a refugee or the first generation descendant of such a person, who experienced forced migration and may have entered Australia in a number of ways including:
 - o off-shore approved refugee or humanitarian entrant;
 - o onshore, community-based asylum seeker or refugee;
 - o temporary protection visa holder; or
 - o family reunion.

How to apply:

Step 1:

Applicants are required to complete the Application Form (either hardcopy or electronic) and the following associated documentation and submit to Secondary Principal with:

- Evidence of the student or parent's refugee status. We will accept copies of documentation provided by the Australian Government – Department of Home Affairs showing entry to Australia on a refugee or humanitarian visa including 'Document for Travel' and Australian Visas for yourself and/or your parents.
- Student's birth certificate, last school report and most recent NAPLAN results.
- Australian Tax Office Notices of Assessment for both parents for last financial year
- If any of the relevant parties are known under a different name to that on their immigration documents, then further evidence of the name change will need to be provided.

Step 2:

Once the College has received all required documentation, an assessment will be made and the Applicant will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application.

William Carey Scholarship Inclusions:

Partial to full coverage of:

- Confirmation fee
- Tuition fees
- Compulsory levies (inc. subject levies, locker levy, Yr 7-9 Technology levy)
- Compulsory camps

William Carey Scholarship Exclusions:

- School uniforms
- Booklist items/IT equipment
- Optional subject and sporting levies
- Optional music tuition
