### Application Form

Parents/Guardians may register their child/ren by completing the Application Form and paying the non-refundable family administration charge of \$50. This is a one-off fee that covers all children in the family and any changes made to the waitlist. After receipt of the application form your child/ren will be placed on a waitlist, however, this does not guarantee a place at the College.

Read about Enrolling at Carey so that you understand the steps.

### Confirmation Fee

Following the offer of a place at the College, placement is confirmed by payment of a Confirmation Fee. The Confirmation Fee is a non-refundable payment to the Building Fund of the College and must be paid prior to commencement at the College to confirm acceptance of the offer of a place.

The amount of the Confirmation Fee is \$500 for the first child and \$250 for the second child attending concurrently. There is no Confirmation Fee payable for third and subsequent children attending the College. The Confirmation Fee is not offset against your tuition account.

### Family Concessions and Generous Discount Structures

The eldest child by age/year group will attract the full annual fee.

Families who joined Carey before 2016 will continue to receive a 20% family discount on the annual tuition fee for the second member of a family concurrently enrolled. Similarly a 40% concession is offered for the third and subsequent members of the family.

For new families commencing in 2016 onwards, a 10% family concession is offered against the annual tuition for the second member of a family concurrently enrolled. Similarly a 20% concession is offered for the third and 35% for the fourth child and subsequent members of the family.

The College policy regarding the definition of a family is available from the Enrolments Office.

### Tuition Payment Options for 2020

All payments are to be made by Direct Debit, which is managed by the College.

If you have completed a direct debit form, you do not need to complete another form. If we haven't received a direct debit form, please download a copy from the College's website. Please complete and return to the Accounts Office by 4pm on 24 January 2020.

An annual statement will be mailed late-January, which will provide the amounts payable based on your direct debit frequency selection. Tuition fees will be processed as follows:

**1. Annual** is one payment processed on 12 February 2020. If payment is processed successfully, a 3.0% discount on Tuition Fees will apply (as indicated on your statement).

**2. Bi-Annual** is two (2) equal payments. First payment is processed on 5 February 2020 and the second is processed on 5 August 2020. A \$30 discount per payment on tuition fees will apply if payment is processed successfully on the due dates.

**3. Quarterly** is four (4) equal payments. Payments will be processed:  
First direct debit – 7 February 2020  
Second direct debit – 7 May 2020  
Third direct debit – 7 August 2020  
Fourth direct debit – 21 October 2020

**4. Monthly** is nine (9) monthly payments. These will be processed on the 19th or the 28th (as selected by you) of each month payable from February to October (or the next business day).

**5. Fortnightly** is nineteen (19) fortnightly equal instalments payable from the 6 February 2020 to 15 October 2020.

### Terms and Conditions of Enrolment

This document contains only specific terms and conditions of enrolment and is not intended to be a comprehensive guide. It should be read in conjunction with the Enrolment Form and the General Conditions and Privacy Policy Form.

### Absence from the College

No reduction of fees will be made on account of an absence from the College, as the cost incurred in operating the College are not lessened by the absence of individual students.

### Insurance

Some personal accident insurance is provided for students of Carey Baptist College. However it is strongly recommended that parents check their health and general insurance policies as the College cannot accept responsibility for:

1. Medical expenses arising from accident or illness;
2. Damage to personal effects; or
3. Property damage incurred by students.

### Notice of Withdrawal

The respective Principal must be given a full school term's notice in writing prior to the withdrawal of a student from the College. In default of such notice, up to a full term's fee will be charged. The goods and services tax (GST) is also payable on this charge. Verbal notice is not considered to be due notice of withdrawal.

### Year 12 Fees

While students typically complete their Year 12 schooling at Carey early in Term 4, due to the resource intensive nature of this final year the full annual fee is payable.

### Variances to Payment Options

Payment Options must be approved by the Carey Finance Manager. Please contact the Accounts Department for further information. All tuition accounts must be finalised by 31 October 2020.

Payment for invoices sent during the year (e.g. Music Camp, etc), must be paid direct to the College within 7 days. They are not included in your direct debit.

### Discount Explanation

Early payment discounts are only applicable to the Tuition Fee invoiced in January. If you are invoiced for camps or other expenses throughout the year, you are not entitled to a discount on these charges. Annual and Bi-Annual discount dates cannot be altered.

### Late Payment of Fees

Parents/Guardians who are unable to pay fees by the due date must apply to the Carey Finance Manager for an extension of payment. In the event that fees are four (4) weeks overdue, the College will:

1. Charge an account administration fee of \$50; and
2. Commence charging penalty interest at the overdraft rate charged by the College's Bank unless satisfactory arrangements have been made via an Extended Payment Plan.

The Principals also reserve the right to cancel a student's enrolment where fees are overdue.

Any expenses, costs or disbursements incurred by Carey Baptist College in recovering any outstanding monies will also be charged to the account.

### Financial Hardship

Many families experience a period of financial hardship sometime during the schooling of their child/ren. Although our ability to offer assistance is limited, we would value the opportunity to work with you through such a situation. Please contact the Carey Finance Manager.

### Split Bill Arrangement

The College offers a split bill arrangement for parents. If you wish to organise this, please contact the Accounts Office. Please note that having a split bill arrangement does not change the Enrolment Form Conditions and Agreement that have been signed.

### Fee Increases

As with other private schools, there are unavoidable annual increases to tuition fees as each organisation works within the economic climate at the time. At Carey, we are very mindful of fee increases and do our best to consider families without sacrificing quality education.

### Dishonour Fees

If a cheque is dishonoured you will be charged the amount specified by the Bank. The College will charge a dishonour fee for returned direct debits of \$10 per dishonour and pass on any fees charged by the College's Bank.
