College Bus Services

Carey Baptist College provides a number of different bus services to our students. A number of improvements have been made to ensure we continue to provide a safe, viable and efficient service to our College families.

The Bus Registration Form will now only be recording your child's name, route and what option you nominate for use of these services e.g Annual, Per Term or Casual Pay as You Go. Please Note: Payments will now be made through the online RollCall System.

There are currently three different bus services available to our families: Contracted Buswest Services (Route 1 to 4), Transperth Buses (#518 and #519) and PTA Orange School Bus (Forrestdale North).

All of the Contracted Buswest buses are fully air-conditioned and fitted with seatbelts. Bus services are available for Carey Baptist College students from Year 1 upwards.

Students are expected to adhere to our Student Code of Conduct while travelling on the buses.

Registration

A new process of registration will be implemented for the start of 2020. Parents will now be required to register at the end of each term to use any of the bus services (except for parents who have selected Annual). To Register for the 2020 bus services please go to our College website to Register.

After registration, parents will be able to create a profile on RollCall and then book their child's designated route and stop, make payments and view where the bus is at during the morning and afternoon route trips. Stops are clearly outlined in our route narratives if you wish to view them.

Students will be required to be registered if they wish to utilise our bus services. This complies with the College's duty of care and helps to ensure we have the relevant information of your child/ren's journey in real time and additionally parents will enjoy peace of mind that their children are being safely transported.

Our Registration Process

1. Register students via link provided in email and on our website
2. Student details are recorded
3. Booking your child on their route and stop via RollCall is compulsory so that entry and exit can be recorded
4. Students are required to use their SmartRider Cards for entry
5. Re-register of services will be required each term.

For those that have registered for our Contracted Bus Services and received your welcome email from RollCall and have experienced some difficulty setting up your RollCall profile account then the following steps below will assist you.

Forrestdale Campus Shuttle

Our Carey Forrestdale students utilise the existing Carey Harrisdale bus routes, and then catch a shuttle bus between the campuses. The shuttle service between the two campuses is currently free. Students need to be registered to use this service.

Once students arrive on the Route 1, 2, 3 or 4 buses in the morning, they should move to the bus labelled 'Route 3'. This bus will transfer students from the Harrisdale Campus to the Forrestdale Campus.

Contracted Bus Services (Buswest)

The College contracts Buswest to provide four different routes to our families – Route 1, Route 2, Route 3 and Route 4. Detailed route information on stops can be found in this booklet and on the College's website. While these services are subsidised by the College, from 2020 an upfront administration fee of \$50 will be payable by families for the use of this service. This will show as an outstanding amount when you login to your RollCall Parent App.

Fees

Option 1 – Annual Fee (Discounted)

Full Time (AM and PM)	\$2.62 per ride \$1000 per annum*
Year 12 Only	\$750 per annum*
Part Time (AM or PM)	\$2.62 per ride \$500 per annum*
Year 12 Only	\$375 per annum*

Option 2 – Per Term

Full Time (AM and PM)	\$3.00 per ride \$290 per Term*
Part Time (AM or PM)	\$3.00 per ride \$145 per Term*
Year 12	Term 4 payment not required

Option 3 – Casual/Pay As You Go

Registered Students	\$5.40 per ride
Un-Registered Students	\$6.60 per ride

Please note, bus fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

*Amounts have been calculated based on 2020 Term Dates. Term fees may differ slightly depending on the number of days in each term.

Payment

Payment for the bus service will now be made through the RollCall parent app via PayPal or Credit Card, prior to students accessing this service. Please email bus@carey.wa.edu.au if you have any issues during this process and we will gladly share a step by step procedure that will assist you.

Annual Fee Option

For those that wish to have the option of allocating your bus fees to your Tuition Fees for 2020 this will only be available until the 6 January 2020.

Any unpaid bus fees will result in the family being suspended from the bus service.

Booking and Monitoring

The facility for parents to book the stops their child will get on and off the bus with what days of the week, will be made through RollCall now, giving far greater ownership and participation for parents. When students enter a contracted Buswest Bus in the morning or afternoon, there is a device at the front of the bus where the student will scan their smartrider card. Students will do this again when exiting the bus. This ensures that the College maintains our duty of care for each student and also allows us to monitor demand for the bus services and route changes.

Students are required to use their smartrider card for every trip to access the bus. If your child has lost their card a temporary Student Card will be issued to student's whilst they wait for the replacement card to arrive. These cards are not chipped, so you will only be able to use them on our contracted bus route to help identify who is catching the bus for a limited time. Failure to ensure your child uses their cards to access the bus service will restrict access to these services.

Route Changes

Bus routes are reviewed at the end of Term 1 each year with Buswest to ensure they are supporting the majority of our student population and remaining viable. Families who wish to apply for a particular route to be changed can apply via the form on the College website. Applications must be received by the end of Term 1 each year.

Bus routes may be altered over the course of the year leading to potential loss of service if it is noticed that stops are not utilised.

Bus Ticket Policy

When students ride the bus and are not registered, parents will be charged as per un-registered casual charge.

We do not carry over any credits. Old red tickets from previous years will not be accepted or refunded.

Terms and Conditions

- Please note, credit card payments attract a merchant fee.
- Term passes are valid for one term only. Unused rides will not be rolled over to the next term.
- If you wish to change your option this can only be done at the start of a new term by contacting the Bus Coordinator.

Transperth Bus Services

Transperth buses #518 and #519 both divert to the Carey Harrisdale Campus, on specific time schedules, and service the wider community as well. Many students utilise these services and use a SmartRider to pay for their ticket.

Transperth manage these buses and times independently. Parents are encouraged to plan their child's journey via the online Journey Planner on Transperth's website. Simply type in 'Carey Baptist College' as the 'Start' or 'End' destination and this planner will do all the work for you.

Orange School Buses – PTA

The West Australian Public Transport Authority (PTA) offer two bus services for students who have limited to no access to public transport. There is a 'Forrestdale North' bus that services Carey Baptist College students. The PTA boundary will determine if you are eligible for this complimentary bus service or whether you are eligible to receive transport assistance. This process is entirely managed by the PTA.
