## **Children onsite tomorrow**

If your child is attending school onsite tomorrow, please make sure all their work equipment is brought back - stationary, books etc.

For now, children may wear their sports uniform every day, until further notice.

Don't forget to pack a water bottle as we are encouraging children to not use the drink fountains.

## **Work pack collection**

If your teacher has indicated that a work pack is available for collection, parents may move quickly to your child's class, collect their work and then leave. If you need to collect your child during school hours, the usual sign in/out process will need to be followed.

## **Kiss'n'Ride**

Our Kiss'n'Ride program is still unable to reliably provide helpers to assist your children in both the morning drop-off and afternoon pick up times.

### **DROP OFF**

Please continue to drop off in the correct zone rather than along the carpark. We ask that your children, if possible, are ready with their bags with them as they exit your vehicle. Children will still need to use the left-hand side of the car so that they are not stepping into oncoming traffic and remain safe.

### **PICK UP**

College staff will remain on duty supervising children in the waiting area, however, children will need to make their own way out to cars. Please ask your child/ren to keep an eye out for your vehicle so that they can see when to move out to the pick-up zone.

Please be patient and continue to use the Kiss'n'Ride drop off and pick up process as per normal. This will ensure traffic flow is maintained and, most importantly, children remain safe. Please also keep in mind that with reduced student numbers on-site, additional car parking is available to parents.
