Jewelled or shaped earrings (eg stars or hearts) are not acceptable. A watch may be worn.

Physical Education

- Teal College shorts (in summer) or tracksuit pants (in winter)
- College polo shirt
- Sports shoes (lace up - joggers only, predominantly white with dark blue or black trim)
- College tracksuit jacket (optional in summer)
- College wide-brimmed hat MUST be worn during terms 1 and 4.

Personal Presentation

- Hair must be tied back if collar length or longer with black scrunchie or “O” ring, black hair clips or black cloth headband (from Uniform shop). Plastic or wire headbands are not acceptable.
- Jewellery: one pair of plain silver or gold studs or plain sleepers worn in the lower lobe (one earring only in each ear). Jewelled or shaped earrings (eg stars or hearts) are not acceptable. A watch may be worn.
- Skirts or dresses must be at least as long as the top of the knee.
- Shirts must be tucked in, unless specifically designed to hang straight.

Cultural additions to the uniform in favour of modesty are permitted only in the following forms:

- black leggings
- a plain long-sleeve white top
- a plain black or white head covering
- Cultural additions must not obscure the College uniform or logo and faces must be visible at all times. Requests for any other uniform accommodation must be made to the Primary Principal.

Notes:

1. Year 1-2 students may wear their sport uniform any day except when formal uniform is required. Year 3-6 students must wear their formal summer or winter uniform every day except when their sport uniform is required.
2. For assemblies, excursions and other College functions the formal summer or winter uniform should be worn, not the sports uniform unless specified by the event organiser.
3. The Black College jacket may be worn over the College jumper, not in place of the jumper. If no College jacket is available a plain black or navy jacket may be worn.
4. Shoes: skate, canvas, fashion or branded shoes are not acceptable. Sparkling trim, flashing lights or other embellishments are not acceptable.
5. Year 6 students may wear the secondary sports tracksuit if they have outgrown their primary tracksuit.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Skirts or dresses must be at least as long as the top of the knee. ○ Shirts must be tucked. ○ Jewellery: Students may wear one pair of small, plain gold or silver, sleeper or circular stud earrings or plain diamonds, 3mm or less, in the lower lobe. No other piercings or Jewellery additions are permitted. ○ Make-up: Students are not permitted to wear visible make-up. ○ Nails: nails should be kept short (length suitable for sport) with no colour. ○ Hair: Student's hair should be neat, tidy and natural in colour at all times. No extremes of hairstyles are permitted. Long hair below the collar, should be tied back off the face with a plain black hair tie or 'scrunchie'. Faces should be clean-shaven. ○ Cultural additions to the uniform in favour of modesty are permitted only in the following forms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● black leggings ● a plain long-sleeve white top ● a plain black or white head covering ● Cultural additions must not obscure the College uniform or logo and faces must be visible at all times. Requests for any other uniform accommodation must be made to the Secondary Principal.
