



Formal Uniform Shoes – Summer and Winter

Students are to wear formal, black leather laced-up school shoes. These shoes are not to have any significant branding on the shoe and should only have a small heel.

Black leather sports shoes from Nike, New Balance are not to be worn with the Winter or Summer Uniform. These shoes below do not comply with our Uniform Code.



Black canvas, flat soled shoes are not part of the College uniform – either with the Sports Uniform or the Summer/Winter Uniform.



Sports Uniform Shoes – Summer and Winter

Wearing the appropriate athletic shoe for specific sports activities can improve comfort, performance and most importantly, prevent injuries. Sports can place tremendous pressure on the feet, ankles and legs. Running and jumping, for example, generate an impact force through the legs that is three to five times a person's body weight. For this reason, skate, flat soled, canvas converse or vans, and other such fashion shoes are not appropriate for House Days or for PE sessions. Students are required to wear athletic shoes when they are wearing their Sports Uniform.
