Dear Parents and Guardians

The Premier has announced that WA has recorded one new case of COVID-19 in the community overnight in relation to NSW travel. Restrictions have come into effect immediately; therefore, this is what is required of us all this week:

Masks

We require all adults to be wearing a mask at school. This means all our staff, parents, guardians, contractors and visitors need to wear a mask. We will have spares in the Office and around the school for any parent or staff member who forgets to bring or breaks their mask.

Primary students do not need to wear a mask.

Teachers have been given approval to remove their masks to deliver lessons, following a common sense approach.

Parents on-site

We ask that parents of older children use the Kiss N Ride to drop off and pick up as much as possible.

Parents with younger children may need to assist in organising the start of their day in the classroom. Please take just a few minutes to settle your child, then say goodbye and go. We will restrict numbers to 16 adults and ask you to wait until the opportunity is right to enter the classroom.

Social Distancing, Hygiene & Cleaning

We will continue our stringent cleaning practices, and hand sanitiser will be available for use in all classrooms. Please follow the social distancing and hand washing guidelines for yourselves and your children, to keep everyone safe.

And as always, if you or your child is unwell, please do not come to school.

The Cross Country will go ahead on Wednesday - adults, please wear a mask and keep 1.5m apart.
