

Carey Right Track Scholarship Secondary Years

The purpose of Carey Right Track Foundation Scholarship is to empower future indigenous leaders through educational opportunities at Carey Baptist College. The scholarships are awarded to indigenous students displaying leadership potential and a commitment to being positive role models within and beyond the Carey Community.

The vision of the Carey Right Track Foundation is to increase educational, leadership and community service aspirations and ability in young indigenous and remote people through developing their natural talents, leadership capacity and academic potential in the context of a Christian witness and community.

The Carey Right Track Scholarship is a means-tested scholarship for eligible families on a limited income.

Eligibility Guidelines

In order to meet the eligibility criteria for this scholarship, students must:

- Be an Indigenous Australian as defined by the Australian Government:
 - A person who has Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent; who also
 - Identifies as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person; and
 - Is accepted as such by the Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander community in which they live (or come from).
- Be identified as a future leader and supported by their community.
- Be a Secondary student or commencing Secondary School.
- Demonstrate an ability, both academically and socially, to flourish in a mainstream school environment.

How to apply:

Step 1:

Applicants are required to complete the Application Form (either hardcopy or electronic) and our Enrolments Department with:

- Student's birth certificate, last school report and NAPLAN results.
- Two references from people who have played a significant role in the young person's life, ie coaches, community members, teachers, mentors, describing the character and suitability of the young person.
- Australian Tax Office Notices of Assessment for both parents for last financial year
- If in receipt of Centrelink benefits, a Centrelink Payment Summary for last financial year

Step 2:

Once the College has received all required documentation, an assessment will be made and the Applicant's family will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application.

Carey Right Track Scholarship Inclusions:

Partial to full coverage of:

- Confirmation fee
- Tuition fees
- Compulsory levies (inc. subject levies, Yr 7-9 Technology levy)
- Compulsory camps

Carey Right Track Scholarship Exclusions:

- School uniforms
- Booklist items/IT equipment
- Optional subject and sporting levies
- Optional music tuition
