Primary and Secondary School

Kindergarten

Summer Boys and Girls

- College Kindergarten polo shirt – orange or teal
- Teal College sports shorts
- College sports socks
- Sports shoes
- *Velcro joggers, predominantly-white with dark blue or black trim.*
- College wide-brimmed hat
- College tracksuit top (optional for summer uniform)
- College backpack or trolley bag



Winter Boys and Girls

Additional Information

Physical Education

Summer

Additional Information

- Hair must be tied back if collar length or longer with black scrunchie or "O" ring, black hair clips or black cloth headband. Plastic or wire headbands are not acceptable.
- Jewellery: One pair of plain silver or gold studs or plain sleepers worn in the lower lobe (one earring only in each ear). Jewelled or shaped earrings (e.g. stars or hearts) are not acceptable. A watch may be worn.
- Skirts or dresses must be at least as long as the top of the knee.
- Shirts must be tucked in.
- Students may wear a plain white long-sleeve shirt under their formal or Physical Education shirt for warmth.
- Year 1 and 2 students may wear their sport uniform any day except when formal uniform is required. Year 3 to 6 students must wear their formal summer or winter uniform every day except when their physical education uniform is required.
- For assemblies, excursions and other College functions the formal summer or winter uniform should be worn, not the physical education uniform unless specified by the event organiser.
- The black College rain jacket may be worn over the College jumper, not in place of the jumper.
- Shoes: skate, canvas, fashion or branded shoes are not acceptable. Sparkling trim, flashing lights or other embellishments are not acceptable.
- Year 6 students may wear the Secondary School sports tracksuit if they have outgrown their Primary School tracksuit.
- Year 6 students may wear the Year 6 Leavers Shirt instead of their College polo shirt.

Year 7 to 12

Summer

Girls

- College summer dress with College white and teal socks
- OR
- Grey College shorts (special order item) and white College shirt with grey socks
 - Black leather school shoes with laces
 - Formal College jumper (optional)
 - College backpack or trolley bag



Boys

- College white shirt
- College shorts
- College grey socks
- Black leather school shoes with laces
- Formal College jumper (optional)
- College backpack or trolley bag



Winter

Girls

- College winter skirt, College shirt and College tie
- OR
- Grey College trousers, College white shirt and College tie
 - College grey socks
 - Formal College jumper (optional)
 - College blazer
 - Black tights (70 denier or higher)
 - Black leather school shoes with laces
 - College backpack or trolley bag



Boys

- White College shirt

Physical Education and House Days

- Teal College sport shorts or tracksuit pants
- Secondary House polo shirt
- Running shoes (can be any colour but no skate, canvas or fashion shoes are permitted). Please see next page for Shoe Policy.
- College sports socks
- College tracksuit jacket (optional in summer)
- College Secondary House hat (must be worn during Term 1 and 4)
- Sports bag

Additional Information

- Skirts or dresses must be at least as long as the top of the knee.
- Formal shirts must be tucked in.
- Students may wear a plain white long-sleeve shirt under their formal or Physical Education shirt for warmth.
- Hat: College wide-brimmed hat **MUST** be worn during Term 1 and 4 by students accessing the oval.
- Earrings: Students may wear two pairs of small, plain gold or silver, sleeper or circular stud earrings or plain diamantes, 3mm or less, in the lower lobe. No other piercings are permitted (including nose, eyebrow or upper ear lobe).
- Necklaces: One necklace can be worn but must remain under the uniform (not be visible). Seen necklaces will be viewed as a personal management issue. Necklaces should be taken off for Sports/Practical classes.
- Bracelets: Students may wear one bracelet on their wrist. The bracelet should be silver/gold with no charms or attachments. The links or width should be no more than 5mm in size. It should be taken off when participating in Sports/Practical classes.
- Make-up/Tattoos: Students are not permitted to wear visible make-up or tattoos.
- Nails: nails should be kept short (length suitable for sport) with no colour.
- Hair: Students' hair should be neat, tidy and natural in colour at all times. No extremes of hairstyles are permitted. Hair below the collar should be tied back and off the face with a plain black hair tie, black scrunchie or black claw clip.
- Facial Hair:
 - Year 7 to 10 students: Faces should be clean-shaven.
 - Year 11 to 12 students: Students may have facial hair as long as it is kept short and neat. Moustaches must not exceed past the upper lip.

Secondary School Shoe Guidelines

Formal Uniform Shoes – Summer and Winter

Students in Years 7 to 12 are to wear formal, black leather lace-up shoes with their school uniform. These shoes should not have any significant branding on the shoe and should only have a small heel. Black leather sneakers are not permitted.

Physical Education Running Shoes

Students in Years 7 to 12 are required to wear running shoes when wearing their sports uniform. Fashion shoes are not permitted. When selecting shoes for your child to wear, we suggest looking at the 'running shoe' categories online to avoid any confusion or incorrect purchases. Running shoes traditionally have a curve at the heel and the toe. By contrast, fashion shoes tend to be flat at one or both ends.

We require students to choose and wear appropriate footwear for activities.

Cultural Additions

Cultural additions to the uniform in favour of modesty are permitted only in the following forms:

- black leggings
- a plain long-sleeve white top
- a plain black or white head covering

Cultural additions must not obscure the College uniform or logo and faces must be visible at all times.

Extra clothing and head coverings must be worn underneath the College uniform.

If the head covering needs to be fastened, discrete clips and non-sharp pins are to be used.

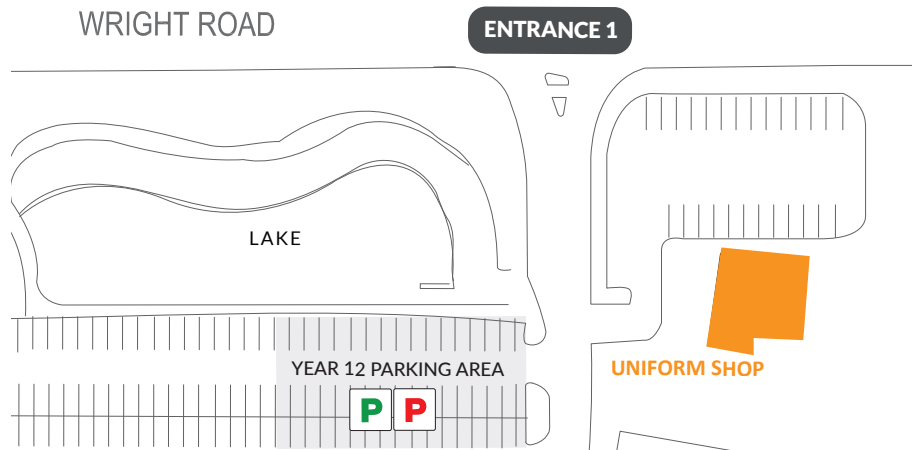
Requests for any other uniform accommodation must be made to the Principal.

Please check the newsletter for additional opening times throughout the year.

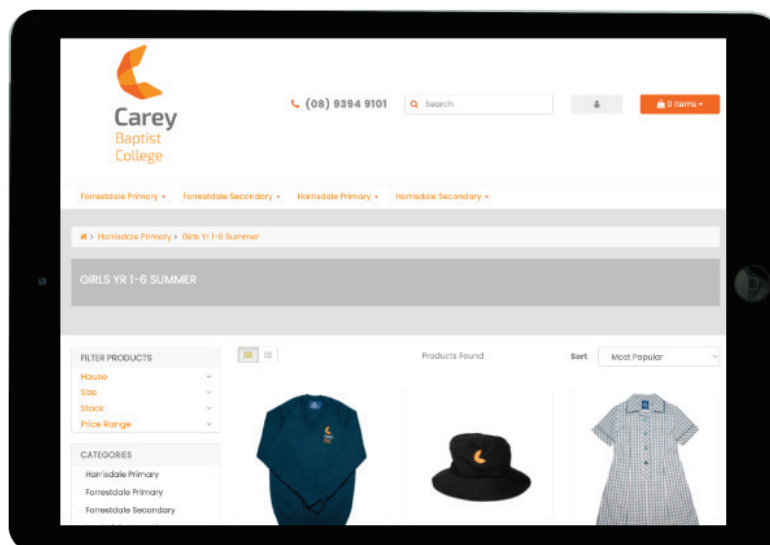
