

Good Standing

At the commencement of the academic year, students are assigned the status of 'Good Standing' within the College. The position of Good Standing is maintained through satisfactory attendance and the continued meeting of behavioural standards. We believe effective pastoral care enables relationships to thrive. For relationships to flourish both staff and students need to have a deep sense of safety and mutual respect.

Carey places a high degree of trust in students, particularly, students representing the College in extra curricular events or engaged in programs with an overnight component. The College has a Duty of Care to protect all participants including staff, and to ensure that program objectives can be met. To be an eligible candidate to represent the College at an external event or to attend an overnight trip, students must at all times (including up to the point of departure) maintain the status of 'Good Standing' within the College.

Good Standing is lost when a student receives a suspension for:

- Reaching Level 4 and with every additional Level received thereafter.
- Reaching PMI 10 and with every additional 5 PMI received thereafter.
- Receiving an Extra-ordinary Level and Suspension for an issue of Zero Tolerance.

To regain 'Good Standing' students are required to complete Stepbacks. For further information please speak with your child's Year Manager.
